Course Content

Date: Monday 14th January 2019

Venue: Moor End Academy, Huddersfield

This session will explore the qualities of a great leader and allow you to reflect on your own and others' skills as a leader. It will provide you with examples of leadership styles and offer practical examples of how and why these can be adopted. Additionally, there will be a chance to explore how to build a successful team and lead others, and how to work towards achieving work/life balance.

Individual Coaching Sessions / Leadership Shadowing

You will also be offered the opportunity to access coaching to further develop your leadership role and responsibility. These will be offered online or via telephone with a further opportunity to shadow a successful female leader over a whole day.
